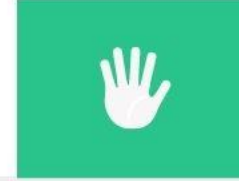

MEDICAL WINGS

- Pilot program currently operating in partnership with John Hunter Children's Hospital & Royal Far West
- Accelerated in response to COVID & Bushfire relief
- Delivered in partnership with rural health services & Aboriginal Medical Centres

RESULTS

- Significantly increased engagement and medical compliance from indigos communities
- Over 4000 children supported in their hometown, removing the need to travel for health checkup or non-invasive treatments
- Over 250 Healthcare Workers have received local, face-to-face training as a priority for the Medical Wings program
